Did you know?

There was an evangelist named Mordecai Ham back in 1934 who was holding a tent revival. There are probably not many people in today's world who have ever heard of Mordecai Ham.

In 1934, there were also 2 14-year-old boys who were friends, one of whom wanted his friend to attend the tent revival and convinced him to go by offering him the chance to drive a truck. When they arrived, the tent was crowded and seats were not easy to find, so as the boys turned to leave, an usher noticed them and told them he could find them seats together.

The message delivered by evangelist Mordecai Ham about sin and God's love deeply convicted the friend, and he experienced a moment of profound realization that he did not know Jesus Christ for himself and he accepted Jesus Christ at that revival. That friend who was reluctant and had to be bribed to attend was Billy Graham, and the other 14-year-old boy who bribed him was Grady Wilson, who became a key organizer for Billy Graham's evangelistic campaigns.

Who was the usher? No one probably knows, but your small acts of service can profoundly affect the world around you!


Ladies Fellowship

We will visit the Fruitbelt farmworkers on October 7, 2025.



Looking at the Big Picture!

How many dots do you see on his shirt?



If you said, "8" you are a genius. I actually almost missed one. I forgot about the one over the "I" in the word genius. What does this teach us about life? It reminds us that in every situation, we must look at the whole picture. So often we don't see the whole picture. This may be because we look too quickly. We don't take the time to evaluate everything in the situation. In relationships, this can cause a great deal of conflict. Even in problems, so often we focus too much on the proverbial "tree" instead of seeing the "forest."

So how can we see the big picture in all situations: relationships, trials and problems, decision making, ministry, and so on? We need to seek the Lord and ask Him to help us see things from His perspective, which is above and different from ours.
