Powerful Prayer - "For where two or three are gathered together in My name, I am there in the midst of them."— Matthew 18:20


Let's stop making excuses and gather together for fellowship and worship.

- Keep Linda Firster's family in your prayers after the passing of her brother, David.




CBC WEEKLY PRAYER POINT

CHURCH PICNIC IS CANCELLED

This year's church picnic, which was scheduled for November 9th, has been cancelled. This was based upon a recommendation by the Witness Commission and affirmed by the Church Board. As of that meeting, the government was still shut down, which has impacted many programs. One of them is SNAP (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program).
