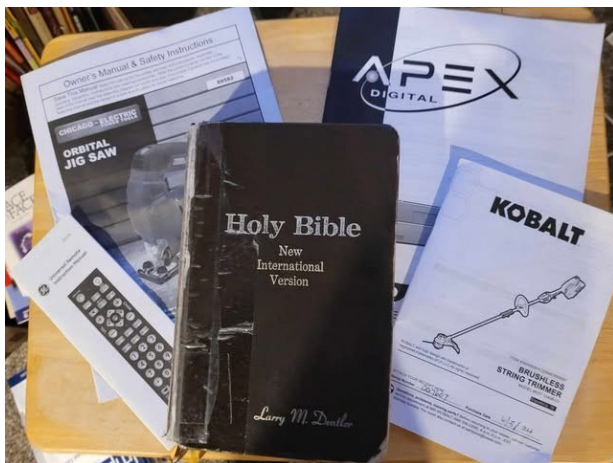


The Right Book

Another child got the owner's guide from their television. On down the line she went. Each child got an owner's manual from some appliance or tool in Kellie's home.

Then she asked them, "Can you help me?" Look in this book and see if you can find what I should do to fix the "check engine" light.

The children began to pour through the manuals diligently. They were very serious about helping her. But one child finally said, "We need the book from the car!"

And with that, Sister Kellie began to explain that it is important what book we look to for answers. And for us, the right book is God's Word, the Bible! Perfect!

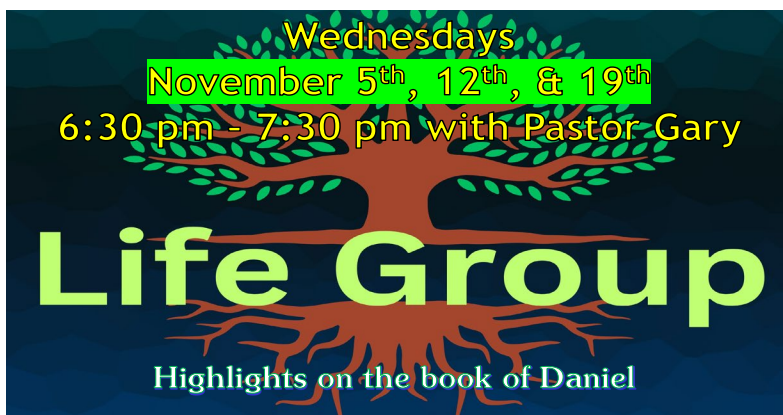
WHILE PASTOR GARY IS AWAY

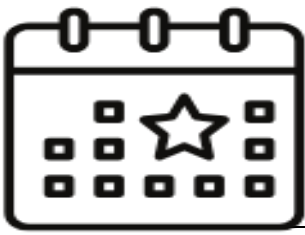
