Worshipping God Every Day Part 2

Last week's Mid-week Lift focused on how we can worship God every day. Today I want to give you a few more ways to worship God throughout the week.

OBEDIENCE - One definition of worship is "valuing something above all else, putting the object of worship first in everything we do." When we obey God, we are putting Him first, before our own desires. In doing this, we are showing our reverence and love for Him. In fact, obedience may be the form of worship God values most. In Old Testament times, the Israelites worshiped God, in part, through offering sacrifices. Yet when King Saul said that he had done well by offering sacrifices to God, Samuel told him, "***Does the LORD delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices as much as in obeying the voice of the LORD? To obey is better than sacrifice, and to heed is better than the fat of rams.***" (1 Samuel 15:22) God is saying here that nothing we do "for God" matters if we don't also obey Him.

Jesus said in John 14.15, "***If you love me, you will obey what I command.***" Truly worshipping Jesus requires that we obey his commands. He summed them up in "love God and love your neighbor." (Matthew 22.37-39) How much easier it is to obey God when we realize that it is an act of worship!

ACTS OF KINDNESS -.In Hebrew, the word "***CHESED***" means "loving-kindness." It is the loving-kindness that is shown even when the other person can do nothing for you in return. It is that same word that is used to describe the loving-kindness God shows us. We need to be kind, gentle, caring, forgiving, helpful, and good to everyone. When someone is sad, show them the love they deserve by being there for them and listening. When someone is rejoicing, share in their joy. Do some spontaneous act of random kindness to someone. In this way you are following God' example and thereby worshipping.

SERVICE TO OTHERS – This is similar to the previous thought but a little more specific. This is worship through selfless service by helping people. Whether it be babysitting a friend's child so they can have a night out, serving in a food pantry or soup kitchen, providing transportation to medical appointments, helping to fix something, worship happens because God is praised. This type of service should never be entered into out have obligation but rather out of a heart, mind and soul guided by the Holy Spirit for the glory of God. When this happens, we are worshipping.

USING OUR TALENTS AND GIFTS – We all have been given gifts and talents and skills from God. Oh yes, many of these we had to develop and cultivate. But even that ability to learn came from God. Therefore, when we use these gifts: music, art, carpentry, plumbing, computer, nursing, farming, accounting, showing mercy, doing analysis, baking, or whatever your talents, skills and gifts are, to the best of our ability, we are worshipping God. We are commanded to use all of them for God's glory. 1 Corinthians 10.31 "***So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God.***"

And so, let us continue to gather on Sunday mornings (when there isn't 10 inches of snow) to worship God. But let us also set our minds on intentionally worshipping Him between Sundays for His glory.

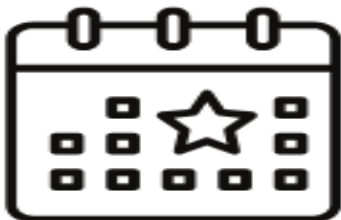
